Footnotes

DON'T TELL DAD saved ground just off the leaders, remained in good position inside entering the lane, angled out leaving the eighth pole and rallied to outfinish SENIORITA STARZ through the closing yards. SENIORITA STARZ stalked the pace racing three and four wide, challenged into the lane then was outfinished by the winner. SEEKANDYESHALLFIND followed the pace racing out from the rail, angled out to rally five wide into the lane and closed but was too late. INDIALANTIC contested the pace racing out from the rail while inside TATER TAM to upper stretch and weakened in the drive. TATER TAM contested the pace from outside INDIALANTIC to upper stretch and weakened. FLEET SILVER came away last and was always back. CONNIE'S KITTY tracked the early pace racing four to five wide and tired. ILIKEWHOILIKE saved ground and was outrun.
