COLEY JOE settled back off the pace racing out from the rail, launched a rally into the far turn loop rivals from six wide through that bend, continued well from midtrack in the lane and rallied clear under steady urging. ILE ST. FRANCES stalked the pace from four wide to bid into the far turn, brought a short lead into the lane but could not keep the winner safe. WINNING VERDICT stalked the leaders racing three to four wide, rallied into the lane but could not run down the top pair. KING FEM E moved clear and gained position out from the rail, made the pace to the far turn and came up empty in the lane. SLEEK RIDGE moved up five wide in the far turn but could not threaten late. SCARLETT'S INDIAN was five wide in the first turn, bid outside going to the far turn and weakened. NO PRESSURE lunged inward to hit the gate hard then drifted wide through the first turn to enter the backstretch well beyond midtrack, rallied outside to bid into the far turn and tired. COOL CRYPTO saved ground and tired. HUMMINATUNE was carried six and seven wide through the first turn as a rival drifted out and tired. CEE'S DANCIN' CAT saved ground just off the early pace and tired.
