Footnotes

SLY SPY moved up to join the leaders four wide on the second turn, continued to vie outside into the lane then kept WORKIN' THE CROWD safe through the lane under steady urging. WORKIN' THE CROWD settled off the early leaders racing three wide, rallied through the far turn to bid five wide into the lane and could not get by the winner. HOLIDAY JUSTICE stalked the pace from the three wide, made a mild bid through the far turn but could not go with the top pair. COLOR OUT contested the pace racing in the two to three path inside rivals and came up empty nearing the lane. SOUND OF PEACE was unhurried for over half mile while out from the rail, rallied five wide in the far turn and could not threaten late. AVELINA'S TICKET failed to mount a rally racing three wide. FLOODGATE vied from between rivals to the far turn and tired. MINNESOTA SLEW was not a factor. FOUL STUFF stalked the leaders from along the inside and gave way suddenly nearing the far turn.
