Footnotes

NEW NUMBER contested the pace outside FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD through the first turn, was challenged by HI PRIM in late backstretch while remaining out in the three to four path, came to the five path into the lane and held clear under steady urging. HI PRIM moved up four and five wide to bid through the far turn but could not go with the winner late. OSCEOLA LIGHTNING settled back off the pace racing four wide, angled eight wide into the lane and moved up. FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD contested the early lead inside the winner while about the three path and had no late run. TOP OF THE HERD checked at the start and was taken back to last then moved up four wide. MITT was five wide in the first turn, moved up outside then came eight wide into the lane. FAREWELL BROADWAY veered out at the start, got out into the first turn, recovered to follow the pace outside and tired. TASTE OF BATTLE saved ground and tired. GINGERS LADD stalked the pace from five wide and tired.
