FIRST CLASS BRASS was unhurried early, moved up three wide through the far turn and drew away in the final stages to be well clear under steady pressure. SUNDAY TRIGGER pressed the pace, raced just off the inside throughout, led in the upper stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner the final sixteenth of a mile. PRIVATE FORTY set all the pace along the inside and weakened. WILL REIN raced four wide and never threatened. LUCKY DREAM stalked the pace, raced four deep and weakened. GUARDIAN stalked the pace and tired.
