STORMIN HAWK made the pace on a short lead racing about the three path, came in through the far turn then angled to the six path entering the lane and moved clear late under steady urging. CRESCO SPORT MODEL tracked the pace racing three to four wide, looked outside the winner then altered inward as that one came out entering the lane, continued on to narrowly gain the place but could not go with the winner. BEGONE JOHN pressed the pace outside the winner to reach near even terms leaving the turn, was packed seven wide as that one angled out then could not sustain the run and weakened late. The riders of both CRESCO SPORT MODEL and BEGONE JOHN lodged a claim of foul against the winner alleging interference into the stretch which was not allowed. DOC CASEY moved up racing three and four wide while not a threat. JUKE JOINT JOHNNY drifted out in the first turn and failed to threaten. DON'S WILL steadied into the first turn as a rival dropped back, saved ground and weakened. MARKED TEXAN stumbled at the break, was just off the leaders while six wide in the first turn and tired. PERSONAL TREAT was carried wide in the first stride turn and dropped out after a half. ENDOSOMEESCAPEPLAN broke with the field and showed speed in the opening furlong, appeared to shorten stride then was pulled up in the first turn and walked off under his own power.
