KING FARHA settled back off the pace racing three wide, launched his rally while five and six wide in the far turn, continued strongly in the lane and held clear under steady handling. YANKEE DON settled back of the pace racing out from the rail, rallied four and five wide in the final turn then could not go with the winner late. WATCH THE GAP broke outward, dropped back off the early pace racing three and four wide, rallied in the far turn and narrowly the third. DECA broke inward, stalked the pace while saving ground and lacked a final closing bid. HOWARD COUNTY HANK was squeezed back between rivals at the start, rallied six wide in the far turn and could not threaten late. FLASHY MIKE stalked the pace from outside, was caught six and seven wide in the far turn and weakened. KIMURA stalked the pace from five wide, bid into the far turn and weakened in the lane. COLOR OUT prompted the pace from four wide and tired. AGGIES RULE prompted the pace from between rivals in the first turn, settled back and tired. SECOND CHANCE contested the pace from along the inside and tired.
