HALF MOUNTAIN CAT tucked inside early to save ground while dropping back off the pace, rallied through the far turn while angling out to come six wide into the lane and moved clear late under steady urging. KIPRUSOFF dueled on the pace from outside OLIVER RULES while coming to the five path into the lane, lugged in past the furlong marker to bump with that rival then continued on to remain clear for the place while no match for the winner. A. K. A. BUBBA saved ground and lacked a final closing bid. TOM TUFF rallied five and six wide in the far turn but could not threaten late. LOUDEN broke into the side of the gate and bobbed at the start, stalked the pace racing four to five wide and failed to offer a bid. OLIVER RULES dueled from inside KIPRUSOFF while out from the rail, was bumped when that one lugged in upper stretch and had little left. KALICO COWBOY was caught in tight between rivals at the start then floated out in the first turn and failed to threaten. AFRIENDFORLUCY moved up five wide with a mild bid in the far turn and weakened. NUN QUICKER showed some early speed from four wide and tired.
