RECKLESS POLLY stalked the pace racing three and four wide, made her bid midway of the far turn to edge clear into the lane then continued to come out in drive while holding safe. SAWYOUINADREAM tracked the pace from three wide early, settled heading up the backstretch then rallied in the lane but could not reach the winner. MAGICALWAYSWINS saved ground while in reach of the pace, angled three wide in the far turn and moved up in the lane but could not threaten the top pair. CATTY CAROL settled off the pace racing four wide, moved five wide into the lane and lacked the needed late response. GAMBLING LADY LUCK stumbled at the start but quickly recovered to move up outside the leaders, bid into the far turn then weakened in the drive. AMARGOSA showed the most early speed from along the inside, continued with the pace to late in the far turn and came up empty. MONEY TAK saved ground and failed to mount a bid. GENTLEMAN'S QUEEN was outrun.
