### Footnotes

RARE CRYSTAL made the pace on a short lead racing about the three path, continued well in the drive and kept safe under confident hand urging only. CHOCOLATE DIVA was six wide in the first turn to lose ground, moved to the inside going to the far turn to rally then could not get to the winner in the lane. MEXICAN TIME prompted the pace from outside the winner and lacked a closing bid. CO SASSY dropped back off the pace racing three and four wide, moved up in the lane but could not threaten. FLOATING ON AIR was five wide in the first turn, settled off the pace racing four wide then fanned six wide into the lane and lacked a rally. SWEET LAUNCE stalked the pace from four wide and weakened. DIANNA'S D. D. was not a threat racing four and five wide then was fanned widest into the lane. BRAHMS SONG was just off the early pace from along the inside and gave way going to the far turn.
