Footnotes

GARY'S SPEEDY MISS settled outside off the early pace, moved four wide heading up the backstretch then was four to five wide through the far turn while moving strongly, reached the front in upper stretch and drew off under a steady hand ride. MISS TWO BAGGER settled outside, moved with the winner while working through traffic from four wide on the far turn, could not match strides with that one but moved clear for the place. NASTY SECRET tracked the pace from three wide to bid heading up the backstretch and lead through the far turn then came up empty in the closing furlong. MISS BEAUJO stalked the pace racing along the inside and failed to produce a final bid. SAL'S GAL showed the most early speed to gain the inside and make the pace to late backstretch then tired. SELECTIVE SECURITY saved ground and failed to threaten. SECRET SLIDER was always back racing outside. SURRY'S PROSPECT tucked inside to save ground, moved up to be in reach through midstretch but could not sustain the move. KIST ALL OVER was outrun. SCHYMM TYME pressed the pace from three wide and gave way.
