THATS RAY'S TIGER prompted the early pace from along the inside while shadowing NO YIELDING, moved to the front into the second turn, shook off a challenge from that one in late backstretch and drew off under steady handling through the lane. NO YIELDING moved to the early lead racing in the three to four path, rallied back to challenge in late backstretch but could not go with the winner while holding clear for the place. BANDINI'S STAR stalked the pace racing four to five wide and had no closing bid while gaining clear for third. CHUNK settled back off the pace racing four to five wide and failed to mount a rally. T J AND COMPANY saved ground in reach of the pace and weakened. LEGENDS PFOOL stalked the top pair from four wide and weakened. OLIVERS SONG was void of any early speed to drop well off the field and only closed the gap late.
