Footnotes

THREE RUDYS gained inside position and moved to a short lead in the first turn, made all the pace and held a safe margin under steady handling. C. O. AL stalked the pace from three wide, bid into the lane but could not produce the needed late run. PACIFIC TSUNAMI fanned six wide out of the first turn, tracked the leaders to bid four wide into the lane then had his rider lose whip inside the sixteenth marker and lost position. ONE LUCKY DEVIL stalked the pace from along the inside to bid in the far turn then lacked the needed final run. PLANTOBEREADY was bumped between rivals at the start, saved ground and lacked a rally. GOATFEATHERS settled off the leaders racing three wide, moved inside through the far turn to gain position then continued evenly late. FROM THE ASHES bumped with a rival at the start, pressed the pace from three wide and weakened. SHOOT THE RAPIDS was seven wide out of the first turn and never threatened. ABSOLUTELY LIT bumped with a rival at the start, drifted off the inside in the first turn and was always back.
