ZENA'S AFFAIR made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail, shook free through the far turn then held clear in the lane under steady handling. ADANCE FOR ADELE stalked the leaders racing four and five wide, could not go with the winner but edged her way clear for the place. SARATOGA EMBER settled back off the pace racing three wide, rallied in the lane and gained third while no threat to the top pair. ASK AUNT AMBER tracked the winner racing three and four wide to late in the far turn and weakened in the drive. BEADED saved ground throughout and lacked a solid closing response. BEAUTIFULBROWNEYES followed the pace from four wide and weakened. TWO STEPPIN TESS saved ground and was not a factor. LIBBYS LITTLE HAWK broke inward but was quickly straightened then remained back racing three and four wide. VALID ROMANCE was five wide in the first turn and tired.
