Footnotes

MOON ON OVER bumped with a rival at the break, forced the early pace from the three path to edge clear in early backstretch then held sway in the lane under steady handling. FIONNAUR angled out through the first turn to bid heading up the backstretch then could not run down the winner through the lane. RAJADOO saved ground while towards the rear for a half mile, continued along the inside to rally through the far turn then angled out in the lane and continued with a late run but could not reach the top pair. KIPLING STYLE stalked the pace racing three to five wide and lacked a solid closing response while improving position late. LUM bumped with a rival and then bobbed after the break, stalked the pace in good position from three wide, angled in through the far turn and weakened. PLANTOBEREADY was on the pace from inside the winner early and weakened. FORTY BELOW followed the pace from four wide and weakened. CHATHAM BARS was not a factor racing outside. SIR THUNDER failed to threaten racing four wide. BUBADAREDBOY was always back racing four wide.
