Footnotes

LOUDEN stalked the pace racing four and five wide, responded through midstretch and rallied late to be along in time. LITTLE TOUGH dueled on the pace racing out from the rail while inside BARRAGE, kicked clear in upper stretch then could not contain the winner's late run. BARRAGE dueled on the pace from outside LITTLE TOUGH to upper stretch and weakened. VADER GRADE dropped back early racing four wide and moved up late while not a threat. WOO PIG SOOIE saved ground in reach of the dueling leaders to make a mild bid into the far turn but could not sustain the run. MONARCH'S SHUFFLE dropped back off the pace racing three, angled six wide into the lane and could not threaten. SOUND OF PEACE saved ground and failed to mount a bid. DON'S SPECIAL ACT tucked in going to the first turn, saved ground the remainder and weakened. TOM TUFF was always back racing four and five wide.
