Footnotes

PAJAMIANO rallied four and five wide in the far turn, came between rivals through the lane and was just up. MISSTA H W saved ground off the early pace, continued along the inside then angled out through upper stretch and offered up a late rally that just missed. HE CAN DO THAT was five and six wide through the first turn, stalked the leaders from outside, bid into the lane and was outfinished for position. EVE N TOUCH dueled on the pace from inside GINNIE to upper stretch, continued well but weakened a bit to lose position. CRESCO SPORT MODEL saved ground to the far turn, angled out to move six wide into the lane but lacked a solid closing run. GOSIDGO settled back off the pace racing three wide, moved out to be five and six wide in the far turn then came widest into the lane. GINNIE dueled on the pace from outside EVE N TOUCH to upper stretch and weakened. ARCHULETA was not a factor. MAJOR EDGE dropped back steadily racing three wide. BANG ON stalked the pace from three wide, angled in on the far turn and tired.
