WASHEBA pressed the pace and drew off to be well clear under strong pressure. BEAUTIFULBROWNEYES stalked the pace, moved up three wide and finished second best. PRAY FOR CASH was unhurried early, moved up along the inside and made a mild late gain. LADY AND THE TRUMP was slow early, moved up five wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. BRAHMS SONG stalked the pace, raced three deep and weakened in the drive. GLITTERING SPIRIT saved ground and never menaced. BLUSHING POLLY showed little. LASSIE'S CAT set all the pace and gave way. LYNNIES TREAT was outrun.
