DONNAGUSKA moved outside LADY COUNTDOWN early in the first turn to join the pace from four or five wide, continued outside that one to edge clear into the lane then was roused through midstretch while moving off. PLAER'S TRUMP bumped with a rival at the break, dropped back off the pace racing four and five wide, rallied to contention through the far turn then could not go with the winner in the lane. ENCHANTING moved with the winner while between rivals in the first turn, continued to prompt the issue into the lane then weakened late. ORDWAY FALLS NLOVE saved ground while following the leaders, angled out nearing the lane and improved position but could not reach the top ones. FORTYFIFTHPARALLEL saved ground in reach of the pace, angled three wide in the far turn and had no late bid. LADY COUNTDOWN lost her footing then stumbled at the break to bump with PLAER'S TRUMP, quickly recovered to gain the lead in the opening furlong, was joined by a pair of rivals early in that bend and contested the pace to the far turn then weakened.
