MISSY CAN DO moved clear shortly after the start to establish the pace racing about the three path, continued on willingly in the lane and was under a light drive to hold safe. MISS GUTS saved ground while never far back, moved to challenge in upper stretch but could not run down the winner. GOTTA JIBOO settled outside off the early pace, rallied four wide into the lane and moved up but could not reach the top pair. FLAMING NIGHT was unhurried early racing well out in the track, rallied five wide into the lane and closed but could not reach the top ones. IRISH FLYER tracked the pace from three wide outside the winner and tired.
