MIRACLE KISS pressed the pace, gained command down the backstretch and drew off in the lane to be well clear under strong pressure. FRIENDLY SOUL stalked the pace, raced three wide and finished second best. THELIFYOUCHOOSE was slow early, moved up four wide and made a mild late gain. GRAND ON FANCY showed little. MAYBE PRICELESS was in tight at the start, raced six deep into the upper stretch and never threatened. HIGHBREAD was slow early, raced three deep and had no response. SILK TUTTA failed to menace. EARN THIS failed to sustain a bid. CLEVER HEATHER stalked the pace along the inside and tired. SELECT PETALS showed good speed and tired readily.
