QUALITY MIRJAH settled back off the pace racing three and four wide, rallied through the far turn to bid turning for home and edged clear under steady handling. MATT N MITCH dropped back off the pace racing off the rail, moved out heading up the backstretch to rally four and five wide in the far turn then gained the place but could not reach the winner. SPECIAL SKIPPY stalked the pace from three wide to bid through the far turn then faltered in the closing sixteenth. TOOTS AND DAZZLES bumped with a rival at the start, saved ground to the far turn, angled out nearing the lane to rally four wide and closed but could not reach the top ones. ALWAYS ON A QUEST showed the most early speed to move clear and make the pace to the far turn, resisted into the lane and came up empty late. SPOKEN IN TONES stalked the pace racing three to four wide and tired. JACOB'S TIGER broke outward to bump with a rival, chased the pace from three wide and tired.
