### Footnotes

FIRE UP THE BELL settled back off the pace racing four and five wide, rallied through the far turn to take aim at the leaders into the lane then continued on well to wear down SEBASTIAN CAT and be moving clear. SEBASTIAN CAT tracked the pace from inside CITY LAKE for a half, challenged in late backstretch to move clear through the far turn then could not contain the winner late. SAINT CHOCOLATE saved ground to the far turn, angled three wide and moved up while not a threat late. FOUL STUFF stalked the pace racing three and four wide, made a mild bid in the far turn but lacked a final closing response. MR. MCGAUNASH tracked the pace racing three and four wide, bid in late backstretch then tired nearing the lane and had his heels clipped upper stretch. CITY LAKE made the pace racing out from the rail, gave way badly nearing the stretch and was eased. KING FARHA saved ground throughout, launched his rally in the far turn along the inside then ran up the heels of a tiring MR. MCGAUNASH, tried to swing out but clipped that rival's heels and fell. KING FARHA was able to get up under his own power and walked off.
