DEPUTY'S WHIRL broke alertly and moved clear of PERMISSQUES early in the first turn, shook off mild challenges from MOLLY PONTZ through the far turn and lane with ease then was roused while drawing off in the closing eighth. MOLLY PONTZ moved to challenge outside the winner into the far turn, made another bid through upper stretch but was repelled both times but continued on as clearly second best. SUNDAY DANCER broke awkwardly then drifted out some on the first turn to drop well back, rallied three and four wide through the far turn and made a late run to best the others while never a threat to the top pair. PERMISSQUES was hustled for speed outside the winner to the first turn, could not keep pace and tired. ANNADACIOUS stalked the leaders from along the inside and tired. JANE OF ARCADIA chased the pace from four wide and tired.
