C O RINGO reeled in the leader heading to the far turn to bid and quickly move clear nearing the lane then drew off under urging in the lane. CAT RULER bumped soundly with a rival at the start, moved up four and five wide to have aim at the winner nearing the stretch, lugged in once straightened for home and could not threaten that one while edging clear for his position. BOXERS OR BRIEFS hesitated to miss the break by a couple of jumps, raced out from the rail while trailing to late in the far turn, swung six wide into the lane and moved up while not a serious threat. SIMON SEZ RUN FAST lacked a rally racing four wide. DESIGNED TO RUN saved ground and failed to mount a bid. MINIMAL RISK broke inward to bump soundly with the place horse, followed the pace from four wide then shied from that rival as he lugged in upper stretch. SHEZA POSSEBILITY showed good early speed to sprint clear into the first turn, continued on a clear lead to the far turn and gave way in the lane.
