SNEAKIE PETESKI stalked the leaders from three wide while midpack, angled out to rally five wide into the lane and moved clear under steady handling. HISWAYORTHEHIGHWAY stalked the pace from four wide, bid into the lane and could not handle the winner. ITZA TWISTER stalked the pace in good position while two to three wide and lacked a final closing response. PENNINGTON J. R. tracked the leaders from four wide and weakened. LIONS A MARCHEN moved to a clear lead through the first turn racing out from the rail, continued on the lead to late in the far turn and had nothing left. DOWNTOWN BROWN saved ground and tired. SUGAR B SWEET got loose while being loaded into the gate and ran off at a slow pace, hesitated at the break once reloaded and was never involved. KIN HE RUN TOM hesitated at the break, chased the pack and gave way.
