Footnotes

HI PRIM settled back off the early pace while four wide, moved five wide in the far turn to rally six wide into the lane closed down the center of the track to move clear. WARLOCK WARRIOR was caught five and six wide through the first turn while showing speed in a tightly bunched group, continued to vie from outside rivals then could not handle the winner late. FRIDAYNITE IN BOYD vied from between rivals in the first turn, continued from along the inside to upper stretch and was outfinished. BLAKE RATTENROLL vied from between rivals through the first turn, angled out to move six wide into the lane and had no final run. SELECTED tucked inside going to the first turn, remained in reach as the field bunched into the far turn but lacked a final closing bid. BELOIT KAN TOO was just off the leaders to bid from between rivals in early backstretch, remained a factor to late in the far turn and weakened. KORONA KAT was with the lead group from along the inside to the far turn and weakened. BAD BIG AL was not a factor. SHILOH'S PAC BOOM was always back.
