LEGENDS PFOOL broke into the side of the gate then came in to put KENDO in tight early, followed the pace set by BLOOMIN AT DAWN, reeled that one in heading up the backstretch then wore that one down in the lane to edge clear. BLOOMIN AT DAWN moved off to a clear early lead along the inside, carried the lead to upper stretch and could not contain the winner. SNEAKIE PETESKI saved ground and failed to offer a bid. ZOOHA'S LAST BABY angled off the rail in the first turn, chased the leaders and failed to mount a bid. KENDO was crowded at the break then steadied from between rivals as a rival came out in the first turn, followed the pace from four wide and weakened.
