Footnotes

BLARNEY BABE was four wide in the first turn, tucked inside heading up the backstretch to rally through the far turn, angled outside the leader in upper stretch and was edging clear late. ASK AUNT AMBER made the pace on a clear lead racing out from the rail, was passed up by the riderless horse in early backstretch then chased that one home while keeping a clear lead on the field and could not last. WILL SHE B stalked the pace from three wide and lacked a final closing response. CONSUMERS YUZUMER moved up three wide while not a threat. NO ICE PLEASE stalked the leaders from four wide and failed to offer a bid. BEADED angled out heading up the backstretch to move five wide in the far turn and failed to threaten. SARATOGA EMBER saved ground and was not a threat. MORNING'S PROMISE stalked the leaders from four wide and tired. ADANCE FOR ADELE stumbled badly at the break and unseated her rider, ran loose along the inside of the field through the first turn then completed the course several lengths in front of the field without causing further trouble.
