COLEY JOE dueled on the pace from inside SIR FOX while in the two to three path, dug in through the lane and narrowly kept that one safe late. SIR FOX dueled from outside the winner throughout and narrowly missed. C O PLOW SHOE stalked the pace racing four to five wide, moved up in the drive but could not reach the top pair. PRIMISTALLA saved ground to late in the far turn, angled four wide into the lane and made a mild late gain. C R GUY tracked the early leaders, bid in early backstretch then weakened in the drive. HALF MOUNTAIN CAT stalked the leaders while three to four wide and weakened. CHATHAM BARS steadied from between rivals after the break and failed to threaten racing four wide. LIL BUDDY saved ground just off the early leaders and weakened. BOZO was not a factor. DON'S WILL had his rider lose irons into the first turn, continued to regain them through the far turn and closed the gap late.
