MAGNETIC JAZZ was angled out through the first turn to move four wide into the backstretch, quickly moved to the leaders going to the far turn to reach even terms, drew clear into the lane then held safe late. GO GOLD bumped with a rival at the start, dueled from between rivals through the first turn, settled back late backstretch and angled out to rally four wide into the lane and was slowly getting to the winner late. CALL ME BUBBA dropped back off the pace early, moved boldly to the leaders in late backstretch then could not sustain the rally while missing the place. JUST HAPPENED dueled inside rivals racing out from the rail, dropped back heading up the backstretch then regained position while no threat. STICK SHIFT saved ground and moved up in the lane while not a threat. SHESAFRIGIDCAT bumped with a rival at the break, dueled four wide outside rivals and weakened. MISS MILBAR broke into the side of the gate and tired racing three to four wide. TAX SCRATCH FEVER was not a factor racing five wide.
