### Footnotes

SPRING BLUES showed the most early speed from outside KING TYMATT to gain the lead in the first and angle in a bit, continued out from the rail when challenged by SAINTLY SON, edged clear into the lane then just held that one safe late. SAINTLY SON moved up four and five wide to challenge heading up the backstretch, lost ground into the lane then rallied back late. VALID THIEF moved up three and four wide through the far turn, angled out through the lane but could not reach the top pair. NEW NUMBER was six wide in the first turn, bid five wide into the far turn then could not sustain the run. KING RED was four and five wide to midway up the backstretch, angled in going to the far turn to have aim but weakened. NEWTONS THEORY moved up four wide while not a threat. QUALITY MIRJAH saved ground and was not a factor. FAREWELL BROADWAY tracked the leaders from four wide and tired. KING TYMATT showed speed inside the winner through the first turn, angled out entering the backstretch and tired. DIVA IN TRAINING was always back.
