Footnotes

FROM THE ASHES made the pace on a short lead racing out from the rail while pressed by FLEXTHEGOLDENPIPES, edged clear and angled further out into the lane then just held late. FLEXTHEGOLDENPIPES prompted the pace from outside the winner, dropped back a bit into the lane then rallied back late to narrowly miss. SEASIDE LINKS saved ground in good position just off the leaders then made a mild gain late but could not get to the top pair. EARLY FINAL stalked the pace from four wide then continued evenly in the lane with no closing bid. BINGOSABLUMIN saved ground to the far turn, angled out to move up four wide into the lane but could not threaten. CENTAUR'S PROSPECT was not a threat racing three and four wide. SUMMER JONES saved ground and was not a factor. BIG MISSION appeared to fight the rider through the opening furlong and was pulled up before reaching the first turn then walked off under his own power.
