Footnotes

BROKEN CONNECTION settled just off the pace in good position from four wide, bid into the far turn, dueled outside ALPHABET ACADEMY to midstretch and edged clear late. ALPHABET ACADEMY prompted the pace from inside, bid with the winner into the far turn, dueled that one to midstretch and could not match strides late while just saving the place late. C O RINGO saved ground to the far turn, angled three wide while moving up in that bend, came out further to rally outside the top pair and narrowly missed the place. MANDOORULE was five and six wide through the first turn while with the leaders, remained outside to be five wide into the lane and had no closing bid. LOTTA CHROME saved ground through the first turn, angled out heading up the backstretch to be five and six wide in the far turn then could not sustain the rally in the lane. SILVER WAR saved ground while with the early pace and weakened. LEAVIN EVEN contested the pace from three or four wide to the far turn and had little left nearing the lane. WALKIN D TALK saved ground and was outrun. MACHUPECHI tired racing five wide.
