Footnotes

REDNECK HEARTBREAK forced the pace from four wide early, continued from outside NO SHUG TONIGHT into the far turn then rallied back through deep stretch to wear that one down and prevail late. NO SHUG TONIGHT was on the pace from three wide, continued inside the winner through the far turn to edge clear then was worn down by that one late. SLY SPY was fractious in the gate, flipped and threw his rider but was quickly remounted, stalked the pace from three wide to get nearest the top pair then went evenly in the lane to save position late. FRIENDLY INCENTIVE settled outside, moved up going to the far turn then continued from six wide into the lane and close and narrowly miss third. HAYN DAWG saved ground and lacked a solid closing bid. MINIMAL RISK moved up four and five wide while not a threat. TRANSEPT'S AFFAIR stalked the pace racing four and five wide to bid into the far turn then weakened nearing the lane. SUGAR FOREST pressed the pace from five wide through the first turn, continued from outside and tired. MR. MCGAUNASH prompted the pace from between rivals through the first turn, continued three wide and tired.
