COLONEL JOE was bumped at the start, raced three wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to get up under all out pressure. MINNESOTA SLEW stalked the pace, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and finished gamely to just miss. GO WEST BERT was off slowly, moved up five wide in the lane and finished gamely in the final stages. HIGH INVESTMENT was bumped at the start, raced four wide and had no late winning bid. CITY SLICKER set all the pace from the outside and gave way. FEEDING FRENZY was allowed to settle early, raced four wide and never was a factor. LITE SOURCE showed little. BRINKER failed to menace. BLUEPRINT BLUE was slow early and never menaced. HEYL pressed the pace from the outside and tired readily.
