FAST CITY GIRL stalked the pace, raced four wide into the upper stretch and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. HOLY CHEERS set all the pace along the inside and finished second best. BEAUTIFULBROWNEYES was unhurried early, moved up four wide at the eighth pole and made a mild late rally. CASH TREAT stalked the pace while racing three wide and weakened a bit in the drive. DEPUTY'S WHIRL raced six deep in the lane and never menaced. ZAINA was slow early, raced four wide and never menaced. INDIAN POET showed little. MOM'S INTUITION was slow early, raced seven wide at the eighth pole and never menaced. ANNADACIOUS failed to sustain a bid. SHE AROSE pressed the pace from the inside and tired readily.
