FINAL STRAW was rated off the early pace, started to advance in the field on the second circuit, taking the lead around the final turn and drew clear. CENTURY GOLD was rank early, settled in second place and finished well, but was no match for the winner. FREEBOARD went to the lead in the early stages, raced close to the pace for the rest of the race and finished evenly. BAG OF HAMMERS raced off the early pace, took the lead with a mile and a quarter to run, made a mistake at the ninth fence, lost ground and could not recover. TRIPLE BOGEY BLUES trailed and was pulled up. REGALITY showed some early speed while jumping greenly and was pulled up three-quarters of a mile from home. PERSONAL TWO raced off the pace, made a mild rally with a quarter of a mile to go and pulled up before the final fence.
