Footnotes

QUECHEE stalked the early pace while racing in the two path, moved up to press the pace just outside PRIMERO PERU down the backstretch, dueled outside of that rival to upper stretch, vied between rivals through mid stretch, battled inside of POLLARDS IMAGE through the final sixteenth and prevailed late in a game effort. POLLARDS IMAGE was unhurried early, moved up three wide around the far turn, put his nose in front near the three-sixteenths pole, dueled outside the winner through the stretch and was out gamed late. SWELL PARTY saved ground through the first mile, angled out in upper stretch, finished well to be gaining through the final sixteenth. DURER saved ground to the lane, swung out in mid stretch and finished with good energy. PRIMERO PERU set the pace along the rail, tired nearing the stretch. REPENTS REDEMPTION failed to menace. BREMO'S BLUFF was never a factor. RED DIRT GIRL never threatened. SUN AGAIN dueled for the early lead, was used up after a half.
