Footnotes

VAMOS A VER set the pace along the rail, quickly drew clear around the clubhouse turn, remained clear to upper stretch, dug in when challenged by DRIVINGMAXANDMITZI in mid stretch and inched away under a drive through the final sixteenth. DRIVINGMAXANDMITZI stalked the leaders three wide around the first turn, rallied three wide around the far turn, loomed boldly in mid stretch then hung late. SOUTHWEST was unhurried along the rail early, eased into the two path down the backstretch, continued to race just off the rail around the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and improved his position in the lane. SPY IN THE SKY saved ground early, raced in mid pack between rivals down the backstretch then rallied mildly. CLASS BOPPER was away alertly, rated off the winner nearing the first turn, chased that rival from the inside, raced in the two path around the far turn, tired nearing the lane. JANE'S KID failed to menace. LUCKMAN raced three wide throughout, made a mild run around the far turn then came up empty in the lane.
