Footnotes

ONE SUNDAY , taken to rate two wide early, angled to the rail mid turn, advanced inside into the lane, shifted out in upper stretch, rallied to command near the sixteenth pole then dug in under a drive. DIP MY BEAK , outrun early, came five wide for the drive, shifted out wider and closed sharply to quickly gain. COAST TO COAST broke slowly, hustled along mid turn, angled in late and closed willingly. CONFIRMONDI grabbed command along the inside, moved clear into the turn, set a rapid pace, drifted out when clear nearing the eighth pole then weakened late. ANDY'S CHAMP , in mid pack, came four wide for the drive and lacked a solid finish. KNOCKOUT PUNCH saved ground mid turn and came up empty. CLASS MARK , outrun early, moved up between rivals in upper stretch then checked sharply when in close near the furlong marker. INVISIBLE GENIUS bore out at the break and failed to menace. UNPINKABLE chased the pace three wide and weakened. SPIKE THE DIESEL forced the pace off the rail and faltered.
