Footnotes

SECOND FIDDLE was rank early, lacked speed along the inside, moved up three wide around the far turn, swung to the far outside in upper stretch and closed strongly to take command inside the sixteenth pole and drive clear late. MAKAAAN was unhurried while saving ground early, eased three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, accelerated on his left lead through upper stretch, took the lead near the sixteenth pole but was out kicked late. LOUANN'S BOOT set the pace toward the inside, drew clear down the backstretch, held clear to mid stretch, was collared near the sixteenth pole and held well for the show. MAKE THEM BREAK prompted the pace in the two path around the first turn, dropped back inside around the far turn then finished willingly through the lane. KEY EVENT stalked the pace two wide around the first turn, raced three wide down the backstretch, bid three wide nearing the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty in the stretch. MINT SLEWLEP trailed.
