Footnotes

SWEETVIRGINIABREZE lacked speed while racing in the two path early, eased out nearing the lane and closed determinedly down the center of the track to get up late and win going away. PIPER SONG was unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn, rallied in tandem with and just outside of FANATICAT and outfinished that foe for the place. FANATICAT stalked the pace while racing three wide around the turn, bid inside of PIPER STRONG in midstretch, briefly led near the sixteenth pole then weakened late. HAWAIIAN HULA was away alertly, chased the pace from the rail, lacked a closing bid. MISS BAILEY GRACE bore out at the start, pressed the pace three wide down the backstretch, bid two wide around the turn, to take the lead near the three-eighths pole, clung to the lead in upper stretch then tired in the final furlong. ALLEGHENY WATER lacked speed inside, passed tiring rivals in the lane. LAUSANNE PACT was never a factor. BEDOUIN set the pace in the two path, yielded the advantage near the three-eighths pole, remained a forward factor to upper stretch then tired in the last eighth.
