DANNHAUSER settled comfortably off the rail, advanced in hand into the far turn, swung out six wide in upper stretch, closed sharply under left handed urging, surged to command inside the furlong marker and eagerly kicked away. POWDER MOUNTAIN, taken to rate, edged closer four wide after a half mile, took aim into the lane, moved between rivals near mid stretch but could not go with the winner while earning the place. CRYIN' RYAN stalked the pace, moved under rating after half, bid to lead in upper stretch, briefly went clear then faded in the final yards. MACH THREE settled off the pace while saving ground, moved up under urging nearing the lane, altered course when lacking room inside the three sixteenths marker but failed to seriously recover. SILVER EAGLE, off slowly, was not a factor. FIRST AND BAY was steadied when in close into the first turn. IN PLACE was sent wide to clear, angled in and set the pace in about the two path, took pressure leaving the three eighths pole, held well to mid stretch then gave way. SCOTTSMEN chased the early pace while off the rail and faltered.
