Footnotes

LYR , quickly to the front, rated kindly while setting the pace slightly off the inside, responded when roused in upper stretch, widened in mid stretch then held firm under a drive. JOY TRAIN , unhurried early while well off the inside, gathered momentum leaving the five sixteenths marker, came five wide for the drive and closed willingly while on her left lead. TWIST TIME TONI stalked the pace, edged closer four wide into the lane, continued on with interest and edged PROM QUEEN for the show. PROM QUEEN was sent up four wide to contention, took aim three wide mid turn, chased the winner into the stretch and gave way grudgingly. INDIAN SUGAR lacked speed, circled five wide into the stretch and closed the gap. GROOVIN POINT , sluggish early, swung out very wide for the drive and was going well late. UNDER SERVED rated forwardly, made a inside move to loom approaching the stretch then faded. DREVAN failed to menace. BRANDY'S CHAMP broke slowly and was not a factor. CAYENNE LADY forced the early pace outside the winner and tired. FLIGHTRISKCOWGIRL flashed speed three wide between rivals and faltered.
