KELLY THE GREAT broke sluggishly, swung to the five path at the head of the stretch, closed and drove clear. BIG DIVIDEND , swung to the four path entering the stretch, was caught in tight quarters between horses inside the eighth pole and rallied. NAGATAMEN , in the two path on the turn, chased the pace, drifted out in midstretch and failed to sustain his bid. JUST BEARABLE , in the two path on the turn, sprinted clear approaching the stretch and weakened the final furlong. CROSS RD ROCKETMAN saved ground and failed to rally. MORE GLITTER was not a factor. PATIENCEGRASHOPPER , wide in the stretch, passed tired rivals. CUSTIS circled the turn three wide and gave way in upper stretch. BLAGOVINO was outrun. HAZEL RIVER sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and faltered in upper stretch. RED HAWAIIAN was outrun.
