Footnotes

FLYING PUNCH broke sharply, settled back into a stalking position approaching the turn, raced three wide around the turn, came four wide near the quarter pole, took command at the eighth pole and drove clear. SILURO raced three wide around the turn, eased four wide behind the winner nearing the quarter pole, closed steadily on the outside through upper stretch, dueled for second outside of TAKE IT HOME through the final sixteenth, gained the place on the wire. TAKE IT ON HOME raced just off the rail around the turn, angled out leaving the three-sixteenths pole, vied inside of SILURO for second through the final sixteenth. CASTLE VICTORY pressed the pace in the two path, dueled between rivals in upper stretch then weakened through the final sixteenth. PRANKSTER JACK set the pace along the rail, dueled inside from the quarter pole to midstretch then tired through the final furlong. DESERT FORTUNE lacked speed along the rail, swung out in upper stretch, angled back toward the rail in mid stretch and lacked the needed rally. CRUISE OUT FRONT saved ground to no avail. GINGER'S JOE broke slowly, pulled up on the backstretch, walked off.
