Footnotes

EMBARR was reluctant to load, vied two wide, took command leaving the five-sixteenths pole and drew off under a drive. CALLIOPE lacked speed while saving ground, angled out in upper stretch and rallied between horses. SAKI advanced four wide around the turn, could not match strides with the winner nearing the quarter pole and flattened out late. REINE DE BONBON settled inside, swung four wide nearing the lane and rallied. FORT BROOK FIELDS stalked the pace inside and lacked the needed rally. MORE THAN MAGIC was bumped and pinched back after the start, raced four wide around the turn and lacked the needed stretch rally. CAT N CABOODLE failed to menace while racing four and five wide. LADY SCHEMER never threatened while racing three wide. REGAL AURORA led early, vied inside of the winner into the turn and tired. LOOKIN FOR ANSWERS was bumped after the start, prompted the pace three wide and tired while continuing on her left. MADEMOISELLE SLEW raced two wide between rivals and never factored. FIRST HONOR was bumped early, raced four and five wide and stopped midway around the turn.
