NIGHTTIME LOVER settled off the pace while racing in the two path, eased three wide to advance nearing the three-eighths marker, swept to command in upper stretch, drifted in once clear in upper stretch and drew off under a drive. SAVE ME SOME settled off the duel in the two path and finished well to gain the place. YELLATTHEMINISTER was off a step slow, lacked speed while racing three and four wide, came five wide into the lane and was along for the show. INDIAN RODEO pressed the pace two wide, took the lead midway around the turn, was collared in upper stretch and tired in the drive. BLUES BROTHER raced three wide around the turn and was never a factor. HE'S APPEALING set the pace along the rail and gave way nearing the lane. TREY BEAR flashed brief speed inside. DADDYS CADDY trailed inside and was easing late.
