Footnotes

LUMBEE BAYOU dueled inside under nice rating, edged clear after six furlongs, spurted away when roused in upper stretch then dug in under right handed urging to turn away TRUTHFUL SAINT. TRUTHFUL SAINT, taken to rate in range, advanced along the rail near the quarter pole, shifted out, made a bold run at the winner inside the sixteenth marker but was held at bay. ROAD TO THE RING rated towards the inside, eased out and gained between rivals into the lane, gave chase through the final eighth but needed more. R BUCKLE, brushed at the break, was unhurried saving ground, worked outward leaving

the far turn, came five wide for the drive, had his rider lose the whip in mid stretch but kept on with interest. SIR DUDE , four wide to five wide stalking the pace, made a move leaving the far turn, chased into the stretch but flattened out. CLASS FANCY CAT saved ground with a mild response. WUTHERING , between runners early, lacked a bid. MARQ YOUR BIBLE , five wide the first turn, faded. ROSES N MONTANA lagged between early, angled in and lacked a bid. TRAPPE D'OR , four wide, lodged a bid mid way on the final turn then weakened. SHERRILL'S HERO failed to menace. LUNAR EVENT saved ground into the far turn and was not a factor. POWER SEEKER lost ground five wide and gave way. RELENTLESS ROB dueled two wide, faltered entering the lane and was eased late.
